PEER MENTORING SESSION ON STORY TELLING

The students of B.El.Ed, first year of Mata Sundri College attended a Peer-Mentoring Session for their colloquia- School Contact Programme (SCP) on the topic "Communicating with Children through Storytelling" on 29th December, 2022 from 2:00pm-3:30pm at room no 311.

The session was coordinated by Ms. Divya Sharma. It was conducted by a three-member team from the students of 3rd year of B.El.Ed. namely, Ms. Sidra Khan, Ms. Tahreema Rahim and Ms. Tanishq Kaur.

The session began with Ms. Sidra discussing the criteria of selecting a good storybook for the purpose. A few samples of such were circulated among the class.
