Place: Lodhi Garden Complex, Delhi

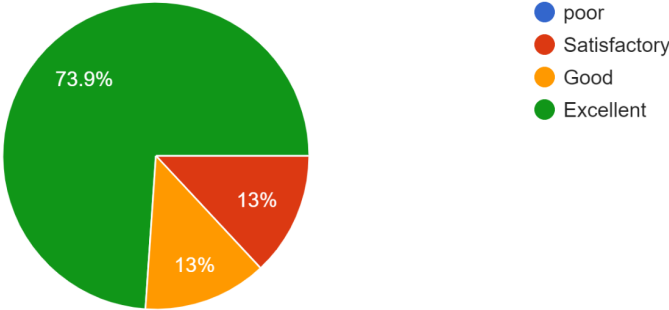

The field visit was organized on March 16, 2023 by Ms. Divya Sharma and Dr. Manisha Subba for second year students of the B. El. Ed department. Two groups were made and facilitated by resource persons Mr. Ramit and Mr. Zubair. The day started with a brief history of Delhi, the four cities that developed after the rule of Mohammad Gouhri till Bahadur Shah Zafar with each one of the learners playing the role of a ruler sequentially. The students were intrigued by the rich history of our city. The students were told about biodiversity and could actually witness many beautiful trees. They then went to the tombs of Muhammad Shah Sayyid and Sikander Lodi. Resource persons gave us time to observe and ask questions. They answered various questions and gave detailed information about the architecture. The students even performed an activity of replicating the structure of the tomb. They then saw the shared family tombs of Bada Gumbad and Sheesh Gumbad looking through some more trees and knowing about their history and relevance in present times. Once the group reached the family Kabarah, the students tried to identify the tombs of the males and the females but they were actually reconstructed by the ASI then also, all of the students did get to know a lot about the architecture of the place. Another interesting site was that of a mosque with 5 arches. The students tried to find the reason behind the same and talked about our observations of the day. The students also did a number of activities there. It was a very productive and fun day as students learned by experience, and realized that concepts they study like discovery learning and experiential learning is practically possible to be conducted with students.
