DIVINITY SOCIETY (2019-20) ANNUAL REPORT

Ustat, the Divinity Society, seeks to create a community of students, teachers and staff who will take forward the values of the Sikh Gurus in the college and encourage reflections on them. The programmes this year, began with the **Arambh Shri Sehaj Path**, which coincided with the Orientation Day of the present academic session on 20th July, 2019.

Interviews were held to select office bearers of *Ustat* the Divinity Society on 28th August 2019. A students committee was thus formed for collective functioning of the society. The student, faculty and staff members hold **Kirtan** at the college Gurdwara every Thursday, throughout the year. This is done in order to keep alive the tradition of singing Kirtan based on classical ragas.

To commemorate the 550th Birth Anniversary of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji Divinity society organised an International Conference on the theme "*Guru Nanak Dev ji: Life, Philosophy and Legacy" on* 27th -28th September, 2019, under the Convenorship of the Principal, Prof. Harpreet Kaur and a Conference organising committee. Several eminent speakers, resource persons, faculty members, research scholars and students participated in the Conference. There were participants from approximately 50 colleges/ Institutions participated in the conference. Shri Hamid Ansari, former vice president of India, was the chief guest at the conference. Notable speakers include Prof. Gurinder Singh Mann (Global Institute of Sikh Studies), Dr. Afroz Ahmed (Ministry of Revenue & Forest, Mumbai), Dr. Jaspal Singh (Member, NCMEI), Prof. Harmohinder Singh Bedi (Central University of HP), S.Tarlochan Singh (Minorities Commission), S. Gurwinder Singh Dhamja (Haryana Punjabi Sahitya Academy) and Prof. Himadri Banerjee (Jadavpur University, Kolkata).

The **44th Bani, Declamation and Kirtan Competition** was held on 5th and 6th November, 2019. Around 1200 students from various schools and colleges of Delhi-NCR participated in the competitions, making it a grand success. The focus this year was on the teachings and ideology of Sri Guru Nanak Dev ji, being the 550thBirthAnniversaryof Sri Guru Nanak Dev ji.

The Divinity Society of Mata Sundri College organized a trip from 25-27 November 2019 to the historical **Gurdwara Sri Kartarpur Sahib**. The trip also included visits to historical Gurdwaras at Sultanpur Lodhi and the Golden Temple, Amritsar.
