DIVINITY SOCIETY - ANNUAL REPORT (2016-17)

The Divinity Society of the college, which is normally very active, was even more vibrant this year due to the golden jubilee celebrations of the College. The following are the office bearers of the society: Simran Kaur- President, Manmeet Kaur- Vice President and Jasmeen Kaur-Secretary. Every Thursday of the week, Kirtan was held after classes. The students of the society regularly recited shabad gurbani. The students, teachers and administrative staff actively participated in the 'Nagar Kirtans' organised by Delhi Sikh Gurudwara Management Committee.

The Divinity Society, on behalf of the College, celebrated the Gurupurabs of Sri Guru Nanak Dev ji and Sri Guru Gobind Singh ji. This year marks the 350th birth anniversary of the Tenth Guru, Sri Guru Gobind Singh ji. Hence kirtan to mark the same was performed by Hazuri Ragi Bhai Surjeet Singh Raseela and his jatha, followed by langar. The event was attended in large numbers by the students of the college.
