

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON ACADEMIC COLLABORATION**

BETWEEN

**MATA SUNDRI COLLEGE FOR WOMEN
(UNIVERSITY OF DELHI)**

AND

**WOMEN STUDIES AND RESEARCH CENTRE
RANI DURGA VATI VISHWA VIDALAYA, JABALPUR ,
MADHYA PRADESH**

This Agreement is made and entered into at _____ on _____ in the year 2020 – 21 between:

Mata Sundri College for Women, (University of Delhi) Mata Sundri Lane, New Delhi-02
And

Women studies and research centre, Rani durgavati vishwavidalaya, Jabalpur , Madhya Pradesh

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

Preamble

Whereas, **Women studies and research centre** and **Mata Sundri College for Women (University of Delhi)** have many areas of common interest in the Faculty of Commerce and Arts considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of education and research.

Now therefore, **Women studies and research centre** and **Mata Sundri College for Women (University of Delhi)**, have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the co-operation of the two institutes.

Clause 1: Object

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

Academic Collaboration

Women studies and research centre and **Mata Sundri College for Women (University of Delhi)** agree that the academic collaboration will be guided by principles listed below:

- a. Exchange of students by mutual agreement between both the institutes.
- b. Exchange of faculty members by mutual agreement between both the institutes.
- c. Collaborative research
- d. Conducting and participating in webinars/ seminars/ conferences, etc. as a joint collaboration.
- e. Any other academic endeavor that augments the students and faculty skills and capability as mutually agreed upon.

Clause 2: Agreement

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration which will be agreed upon mutually. Terms and conditions for each assignment or such exchange, including those concerning remunerations, and travel funding will be mutually worked out between the two institutes.

Clause 3: Co-ordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a Coordination Committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of **Women studies and research centre**, and a programme coordinator from the side of **Mata Sundri College for Women (University of Delhi)** will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen co-operation between the two institutes.

Clause 4: Validity

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of Two years commencing from the effective above mentioned date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

Clause 5: Termination

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institute. Once terminated, neither **Women studies and research centre** and **Mata Sundri College for Women (University of Delhi)**, will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutes may suffer. However, **Women studies and research centre** and **Mata Sundri College for Women (University of Delhi)** will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

Clause 6: Amendments / Modifications

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

Clause 7: Adherence To Rules

Participating staff members and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the rules and regulations of the institutes.

Clause 8: Legal Right

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

Clause 9: Dispute Resolution

In case, there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic co-operation, Heads of Institutes, namely, **Women studies and research centre** and **Mata Sundri College for Women (University of Delhi)** will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

Women studies and research centre and **Mata Sundri College for Women (University of Delhi)** welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for co-operation and jointly agree to the provisions as set out above.
