



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### Report: Short Term Skill Development Certificate Course on Python for Machine Learning and Data Science

Department of Mathematics and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Mata Sundri College for Women in collaboration with 9LedgePro-Microsoft Partner Network organized a Short Term Skill Development Certificate Course on "Python for Machine Learning and Data Science". The course commenced on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020 with an inaugural ceremony which began with a melodious rendition of the college prayer. The Course Coordinator, Ms. Sonia Aneja welcomed the Principal Prof. Harpreet Kaur, the Course Speaker Mr. Parth Shukla, Co-founder, 9LedgePro-Microsoft Partner Network and the Teacher-In-Charge (TIC) of Department of Mathematics Ms. Mandeep Walia. The Principal then addressed the participants and motivated them with encouraging words. TIC also wished the students all the best for the successful completion of the course. The duration of the course was 30 hours. There were 12 live sessions, out of which 6 sessions of 3 hours each were held on weekends and 6 sessions of 2 hours each were held on the weekdays. Live sessions were conducted on Microsoft Teams. It was attended by 53 students.

The objective of the course was specifically to introduce various concepts of Python programming which would enable the participants to gain basic understanding of the tools and techniques involving in Data Sciences while providing exposure to different applications of Python through projects such as sentiment analysis, detection of fake news etc. Several useful topics like Python Data Structures, Python Programming Fundamentals, NumPy, Pandas and Matplotlib, Introduction to Machine Learning (ML) were covered. Students created python scripts and worked on the data-sets to apply ML. The Instructor interacted with the students on one-to-one basis and took their doubts in each session. 6 assessments and a final test were taken during the course to strengthen their knowledge of the Python language.

The live sessions concluded on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2020 with a closing ceremony where the TIC, Ms. Mandeep Walia and the Course Coordinator Ms. Sonia Aneja proposed a vote of thanks and some of the participants shared their experiences and feedback of the course. The students participated in full enthusiasm and found the course beneficial and interesting. Successful students were given E-Certificates at the end of the course.

## Report: Faculty Development Programme on Exploratory Data Analysis using Statistical Software R and SPSS

The seven day Faculty Development Programme on 'Exploratory Data Analysis using Statistical Software R and SPSS' was organized by Department of Statistics and Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Mata Sundri College for Women in collaboration with Mahatma Hansraj Faculty Development Centre, Hansraj College (initiative of MHRD, Govt of India under Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching scheme) from 7th January 2021 to 13th January 2021. The programme was attended by around 150 participants from across the country and also abroad. The intellectually stimulating programme was enriching and proved to be helpful in improving analytical skills of the faculty and research scholars who attended the session.

Dr. Archana Verma, Faculty, Department of Statistics, Mata Sundri College for Women and Convenor of the Faculty Development Programme, welcomed all the participants. This was followed by a formal introduction

by Mrs. Prabhsharan Kaur, teacher in- charge, Department of Statistics. Opening remarks for the event were given by our respected Principal Prof (Dr.) Harpreet Kaur. Dr. Lokesh Kumar Gupta, Coordinator IQAC gave a brief account of the activities being carried out in Mata Sundri College for Women during the Covid pandemic.

The programme progressed with different speakers from different backgrounds. The participants found it very engaging and gave an overwhelming response. The speaker addressed all the queries of participants patiently. In the end, there was a small valedictory session wherein Ms. Prabhsharan Kaur thanked all the organizing team members of both the colleges, speakers and the participants. Participants also shared their views regarding the course content of the FDP and gave a unanimous view that this one week FDP was very well organized and course content was immensely informative and enriching.



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The inaugural lecture was given by Prof Vikram Dayal, Institute of Economic Growth in which he mainly focused on how visualization is critical to data analysis and how data graphics give us great insights about the data and how that can be done with ease in 'R'.





The resource person for the first session was Dr. Seema Gupta, Associate Professor, Ram Lal Anand College, Delhi University. Starting with the basic terminology of Statistics, she discussed types of data in research and the methods used for data analysis in qualitative and quantitative research. She explained Exploratory Data Analysis through various forms of graphs and how to interpret them.

The lecture titled "Statistical Modeling and Model Diagnostics" was delivered by Dr. Babita Goyal, Associate Professor, Ramjas College, University of Delhi. She discussed that, raw data are merely numbers but they have great stories to tell if analyzed properly. She also discussed about the sources of data collection, variation in the data and designing part of the data and the results which were obtained from the analysis.





The sessions on R programming were conducted by Dr. Hukum Chandra, National Fellow & Principal Scientist, ICAR-IASRI. His sessions justified the immense popularity of R in academia. Since it was a hands-on session, the participants found it very engaging and gave an overwhelming response.

The session on multivariate analysis techniques using R software was taken up by Dr. Pradip Basak, Assistant Professor, Department of Agricultural Statistics, Uttar Banga Krishi Viswavidyalaya, West Bengal.





The sessions on SPSS were conducted by Dr. Suresh Kumar Sharma, Professor, Department of Statistics, Panjab University, Chandigarh. His sessions were engaging and imparted great conceptual clarity and knowledge to work in SPSS with ease.

Exploratory Data Analysis (EDA), which is performed before a formal analysis, plays a critical role in data analysis process by maximizing the insights of a dataset and minimizing potential error later in the analysis. It is the process of performing initial investigations on data so as to uncover underlying structure and patterns in the data, identify important variables, identify anomalies, test a hypothesis, check assumptions, set the stage for model development and further statistical analysis.

This course on Exploratory Data Analysis using Statistical Software R and SPSS aims to introduce the participants with different aspects of exploratory analysis techniques essential for getting an insight of the data and subsequently implementing an appropriate statistical analysis. It will provide a platform to the participants to deal with various types of data, getting meaningful insights, data visualization, extracting important features and perform the analysis using software R and SPSS. This course will cover different statistical methods and graphics systems essential for exploratory analysis including descriptive statistics, probability distributions, hypothesis testing, statistical modeling, and multivariate techniques to visualize high-dimensional data etc.

In the recent past, R software, which is an open source statistical software used to visualize, manipulate and analyze the data, has received considerable popularity among the different domains of statistical science. It is the most widely used language in the world of data science. Being simple, well-developed and effective programming language, R provides very flexible language, effective data handling and storage facility, extensive and integrated collection of tools and graphical facilities for data analysis and display. Due to its robust features and effective data handling facility major organizations and universities use R for data analysis. SPSS on the other hand is a commonly used software popular for data analysis for many years. It is designed in such a way that it can handle a large set of variable data formats as well as help in processing critical data analysis in simple steps.

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


Image 1: Ongoing Session in Faculty Development Programme on Exploratory Data Analysis using Statistical Software R and SPSS



#### **Enactus**

#### E waste collection drive.

Enactus began with its first project on 27th August 2019. It aimed to collect electronic waste available with the students and college authorities. Contributions were made on a large scale. The team ensured the smooth working of the drive and successfully collected 19 kgs of e-waste. The boxes for collection were placed near the Gurudwara and the lift on the ground floor. Students were encouraged to bring the waste via campaigning done both online and offline modes.

The e-waste collection drive ran for two months. The team collaborated with a NGO namely Chintan so that the material collected could be **reused** or **disposed off in an environmentally safe manner**. The last date for the campaign was 4th October.





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#### T3 ANAEMIA CAMP

Enactus for its second project collaborated with NCC to organise a camp on anaemia followed by a talk afterwards in the college on 20th September 2019. The objective of the camp was to generate awareness among the students regarding anaemia. Dr. Puneet Jaitley, programme officer for the central district arranged a meeting with our Principal Ma'am, Prof (Dr.) Mrs. Harpreet Kaur to organise the anemic camp in our college. Enactus and NCC were given the responsibility to oversee the modus operandi of the camp. The T3 camp consisted of 2 camp



sites, in-front of the Gurudwara and in the counsellor room on the ground floor. There were 5 teams, assisted by two doctors and each team consisted of a pathologist and a counsellor. Facilities of free hemoglobin checkup were provided and students identified to be anemic were issued with IFA, Vitamin C and Albendazole tablet. They were also encouraged to attend the interactive session with the doctors. The Enactus team ensured the smooth

working of the drive and refreshments were provided to the teams.





The counselling session was conducted by Dr. Puneet Jaitley. He discussed the symptoms of anaemia, spread awareness about different levels of anaemia: from being mildly/ moderately anaemic to being severely anaemic, provided nutrition counselling for the same and advised the students to take further treatment at nearby dispensaries.

The Enactus team encouraged the student participation via campaigning done both online and offline. Messages about the same were circulated, posters were put up on the notice boards and and several announcements were made in the classrooms.

Total 862 students were tested, out of which 194 students were non anemic, 404 students were mildly anemic, 261 students were moderately anemic and 3 students were severely anemic.

The camp site was operational from 9:30 AM to 1:30 PM and the interactive session was orchestrated from 12:30 PM to 1:30 PM.









