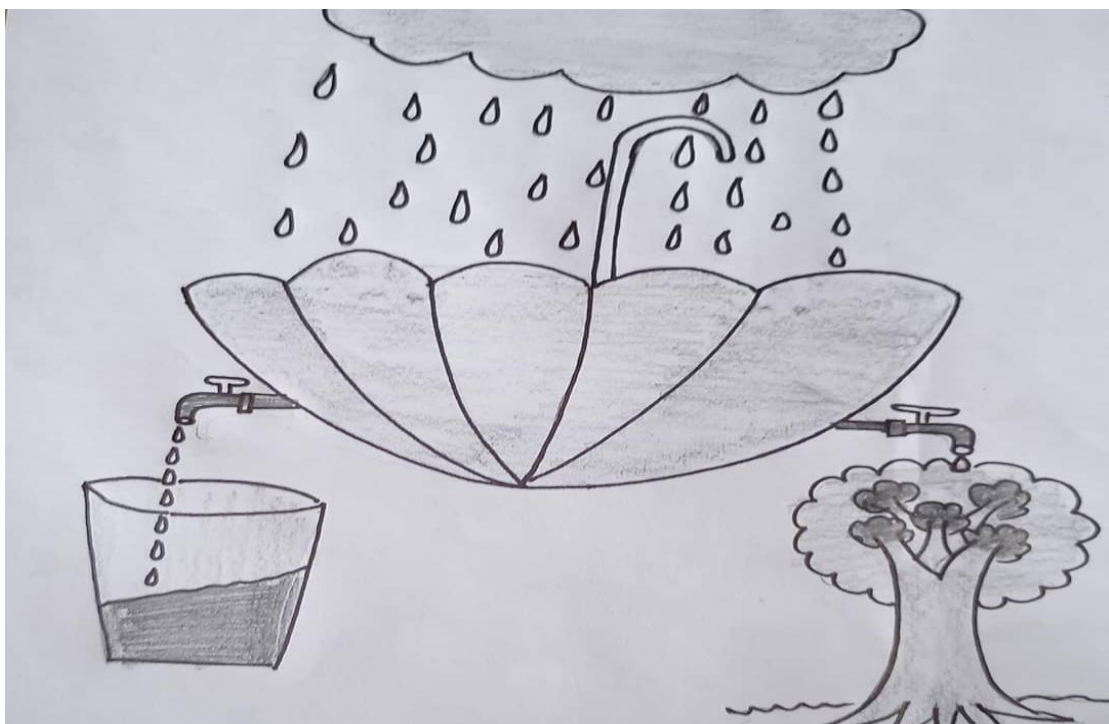


Figure 6 : Poster inviting students to participate in innovative events on the occasion of World Water Day



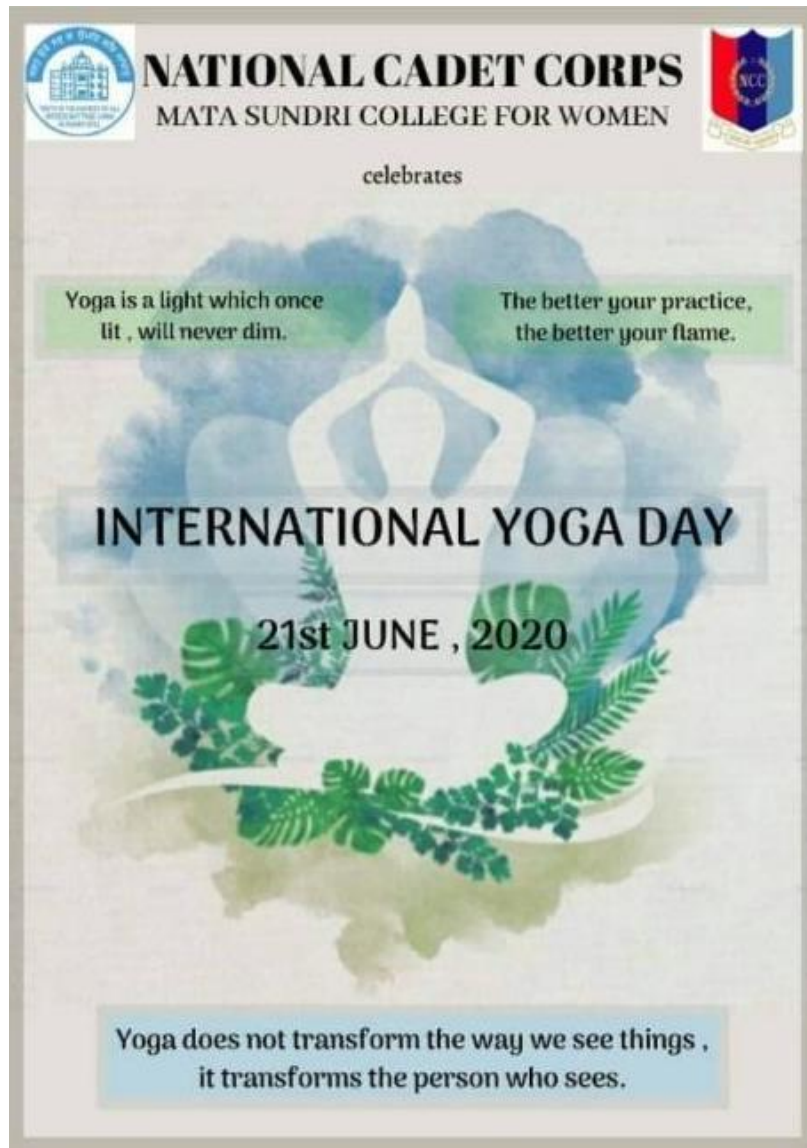


Figure 16 : Poster of NCC organizing International Yoga Day

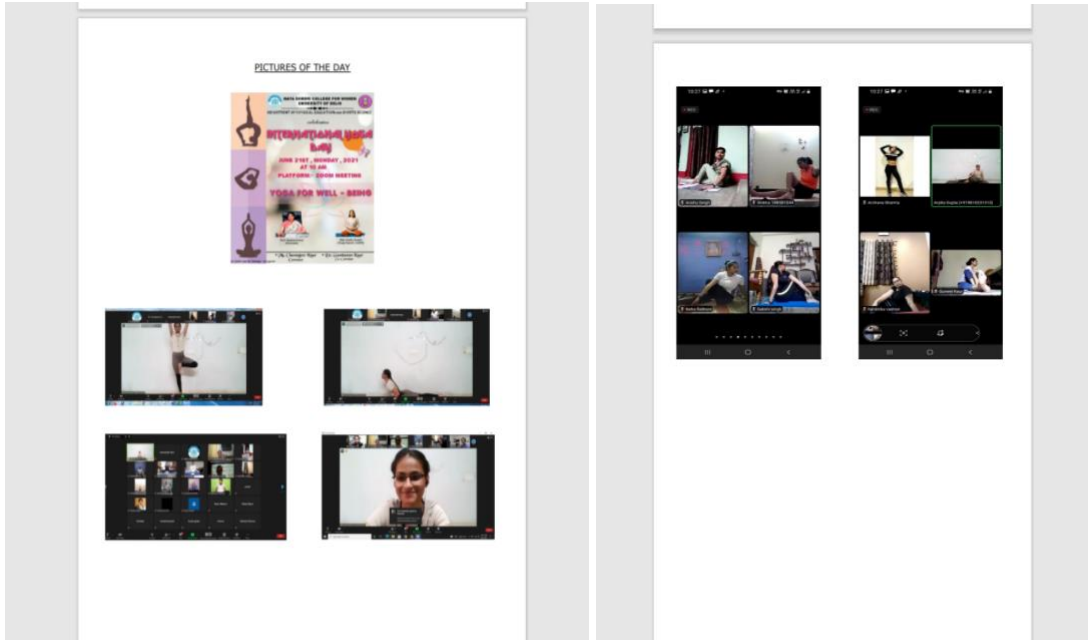


Figure 18 : Report and pictures of 7th International Yoga Day Celebration

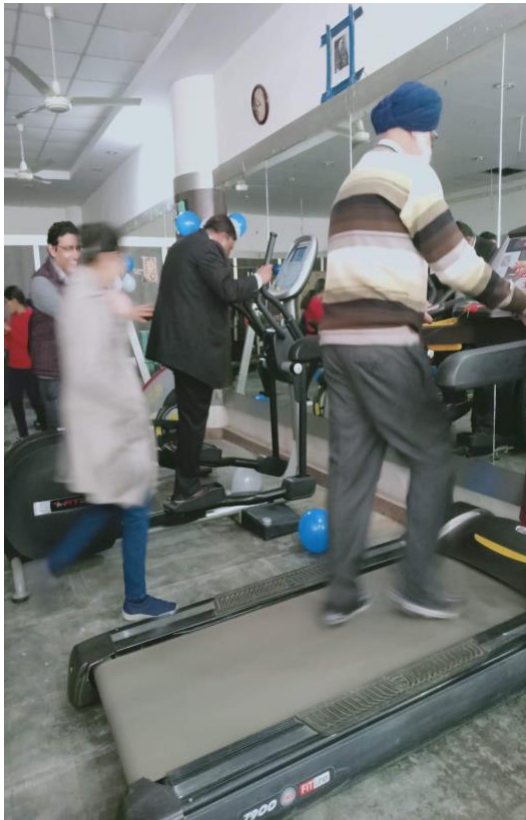


Figure 20 : Glimpse of Gym Inaugural Day

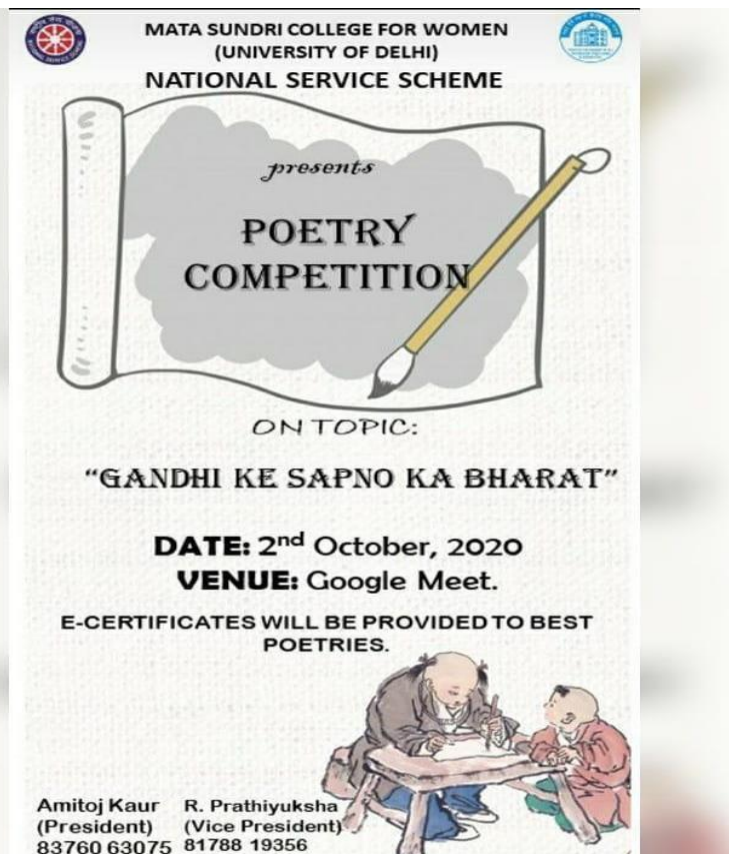


Figure 22 : Poster of poetry competition organised to commemorate Non-Violence Day

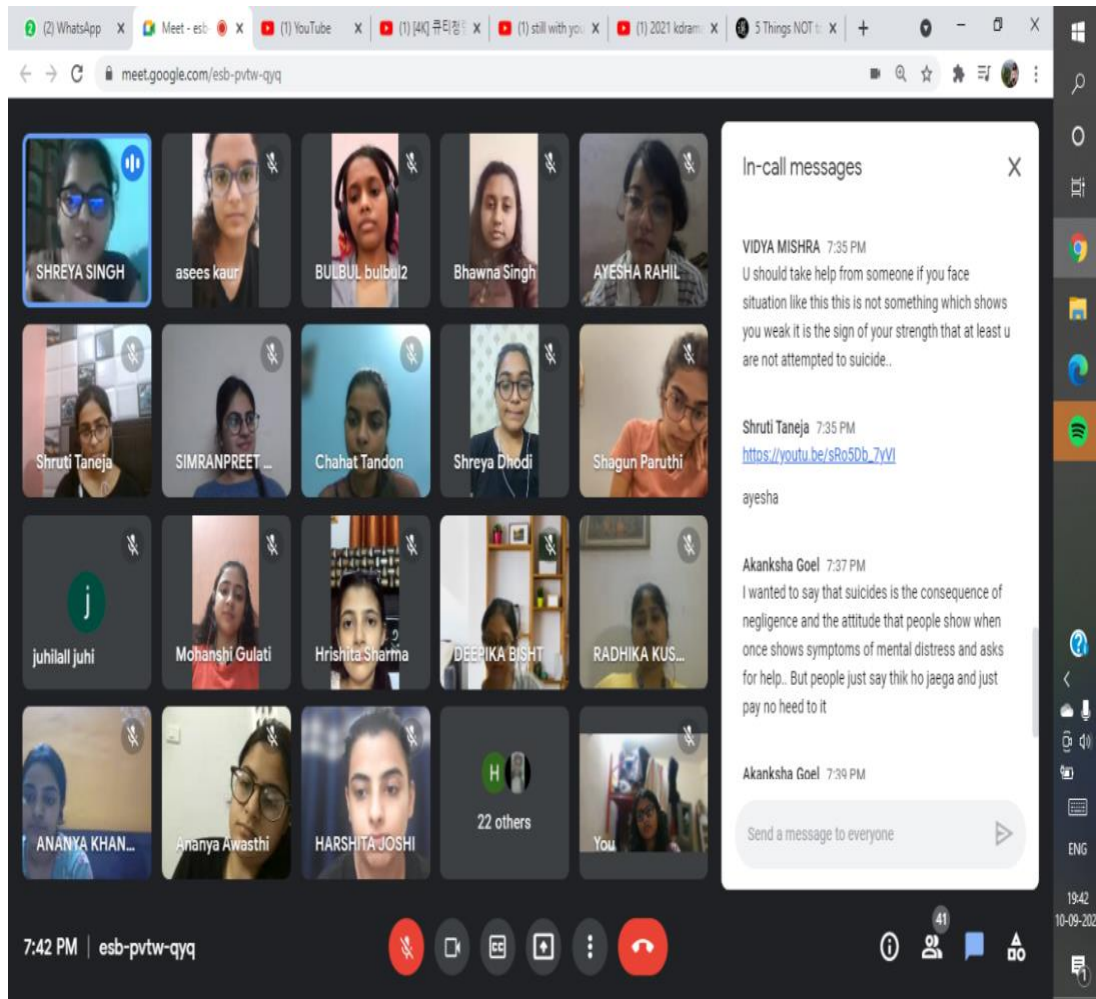


Figure 26 : Students participating in the online Ted Talks on World Suicide Prevention Day.

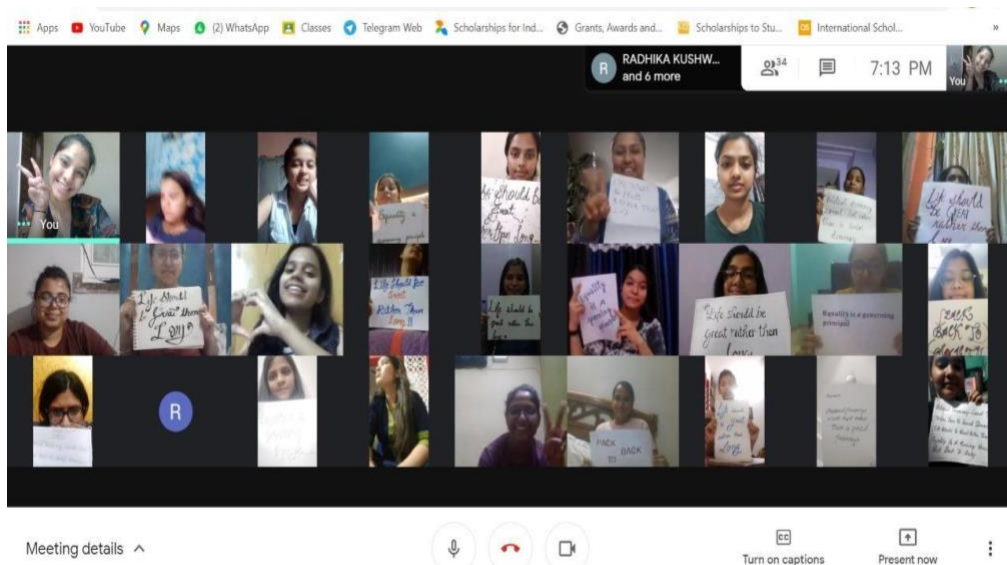


Figure 44 : Poster and on-going session of Quiz organized on Ambedkar Jyanti

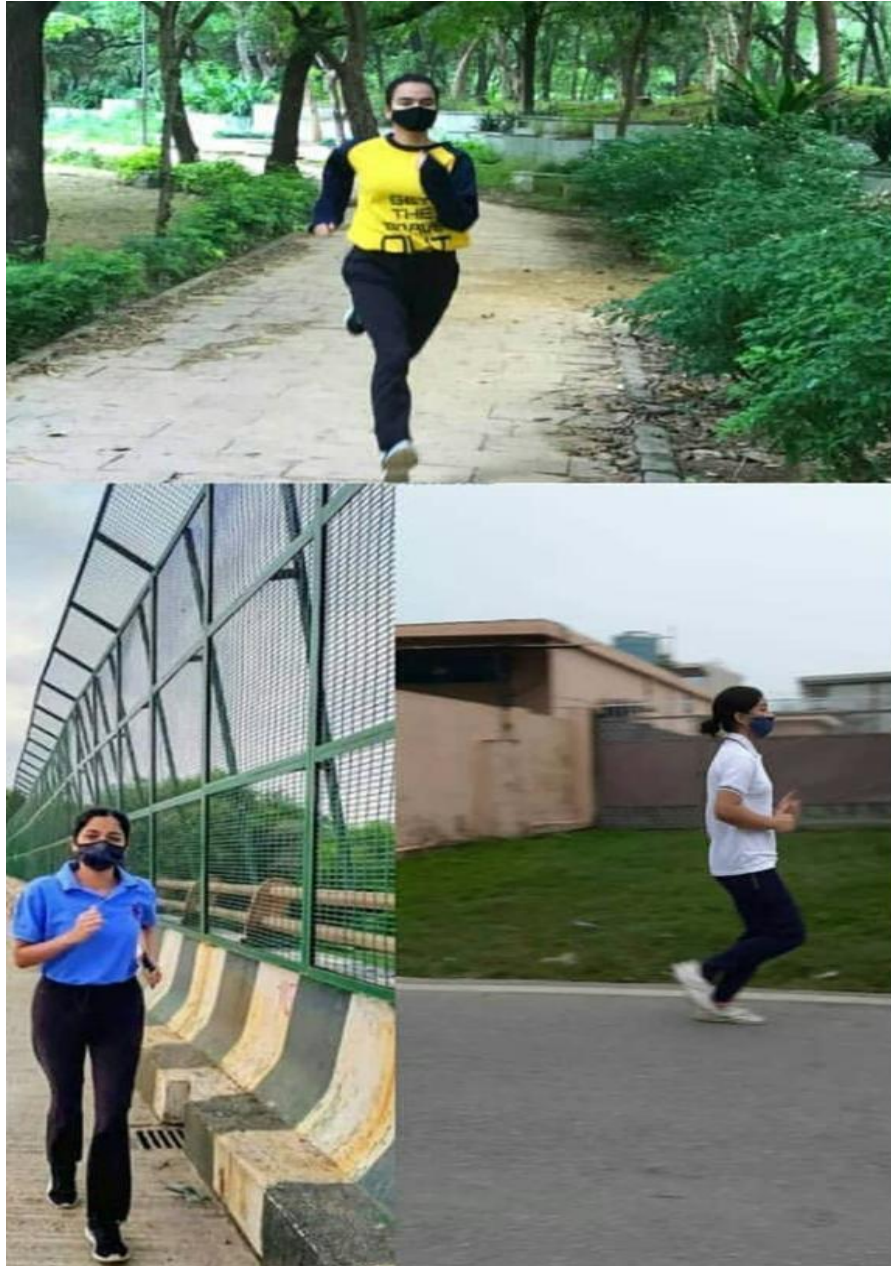


Figure 53 : Students participating in Fit India movement Run

13. All important festivals like *Safe Holi*, *Green Diwali*, *Lorhi*, *Baishakhi*, are celebrated in college by students and staff.

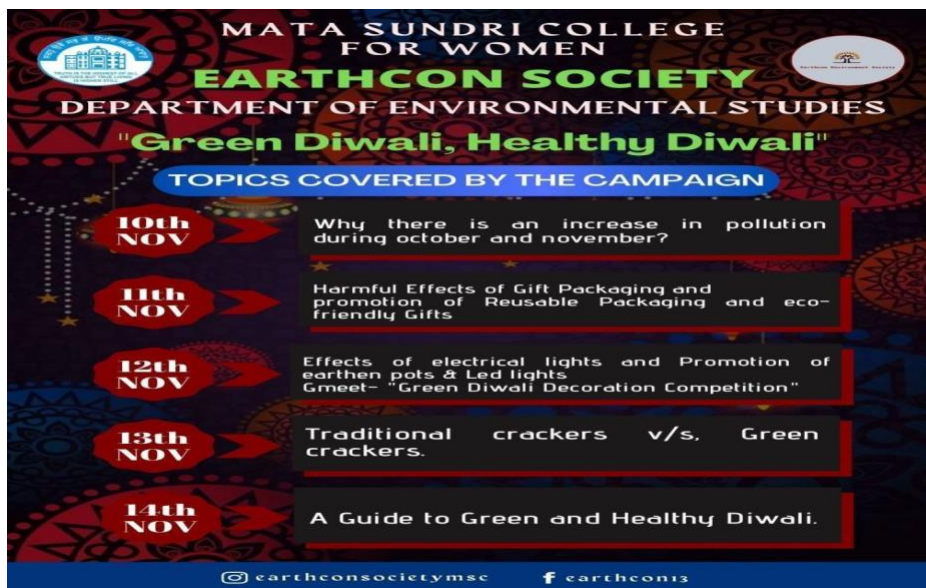


Figure 54 : Photographs of posters spreading awareness on Green Diwali

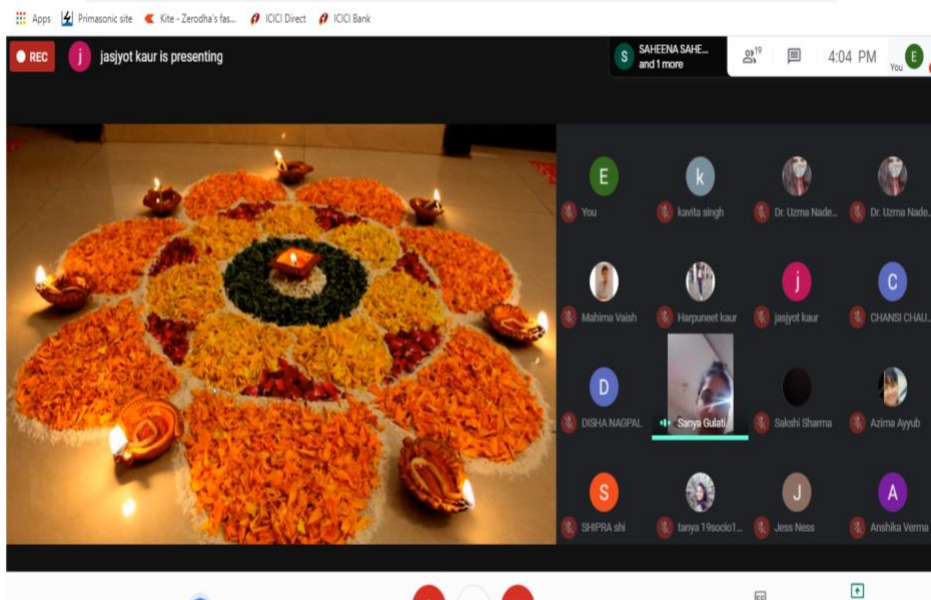
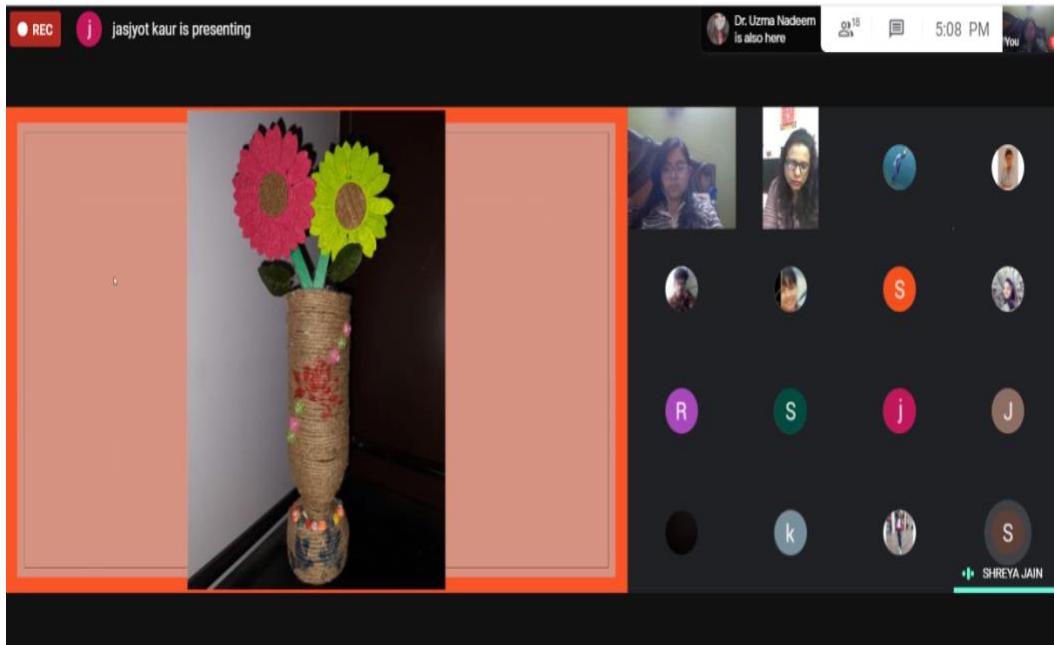


Figure 55 : Photos of the online session on Green Diwali

Seminar Overview

The National Seminar aims to discuss the relevance of Guru Nanak Dev Ji's teachings in the modern world emphasizing value education. Profounder of a new religion, Guru Nanak Dev Ji was a versatile genius who dealt with all phases of life elaborately. Guru Nanak Dev Ji led a simple but extraordinary life, preaching a straightforward way to find God in one's own heart through inner purity and social responsibility. He preached profusely on religion, philosophy, moral and social ethics, education, social welfare, economic and political evils of his time. From an early age Guru Nanak Dev Ji showed particular interest in spiritual matters. He became acquainted with the teachings of both Hinduism and Islam and met holy men of both religions. In the process, he developed distaste for the superficial aspects of religious practice, questioning their efficacy and value in achieving God realization such as caste and gender inequalities, sacrificial rituals and sati system.

In his life time Guru Nanak Dev Ji personified humility and simplicity. The highest education, according to him, is that which develops the whole man in a way that he realizes God's existence and gets in tune with Him. He believed that all human beings are created equal and endowed with the same potential. Human can achieve his highest potential by remembrance of the name of God (nam japo), honest labour (kirat karanam) and sharing (vand chhakna).
