


Figure 1: Poster of short term course on Sri Guru Granth Sahib




Figure 3: College notice related to Gurupurab celebration




Figure 6 : Bani Declamation and Kirtan Competition - Notice






Figure 7 : College celebrating Bani Declamation and Kirtan Competition




Figure 12: Poster on special lecture on the occasion of Sri Guru Harikrishan Sahib Ji's birth anniversary.

• Kartarpur Sahib Gurdwara in Pakistan commemorates the site where Guru Nanak spent the last 18 years of his life. The opening of the historic Kartarpur Corridor on 12 November 2019 was a cherished dream for many Indians that facilitated the Indian pilgrims a rare visa-free access to the Kartarpur Sahib Gurdwara. To commemorate the 550th Birth Anniversary of Sri Guru Nanak Devi Ji, the Divinity Society of Mata Sundri College organized a trip from 25-27 November 2019 to the historical Gurdwara Sri Kartarpur Sahib. The trip also included visit to historical Gurdwaras at Sultanpur Lodhi and the Golden Temple, Amritsar. 


Figure 15: Poster of Saragarhi Day celebration.




Figure 26: Posters on Fit India Movement




Figure 34: Golden Jublee Celebration.




Figure 37: Poster on organising Essay Competition on the occasion of Golden Jublee Celebration.




Figure 52: Mata Sundri ji Gurudwara.






Figure 53: Mata Sundri Ji Gurudwara.




Figure 54: Mata Sundri Ji Gurudwara in the college premises.
