Policy Document for Differently Abled

We have the following Policies towards Differently Abled individuals.

Enabling Unit

The Enabling Unit of Mata Sundri College was established in 2010-11 to provide accessible education with equal facilities for differently abled staff and students. The unit should make continuous efforts to make the College barrier free.

There are many types of equipment for differently-abled persons which should be made available to them whenever deemed necessary.

Braille embosser, smart phones, laptop and other devices to facilitate the learning process of differently able students should be made readily available.

Infrastructure

The ramps, rails, trails and lifts in the College premises should be disabled friendly in order to ease the mobility of person with disability.

The College campus should have appropriate Braille marking and announcement system in lift for people with disability to comprehend the process.

There should be appropriate Tactile paths for visually impaired that further enhances the comfort of their movement and empowers them to access the College campus on their own.

The dedicated washrooms for differently abled students and staff should be cleaned and maintained regularly.

Library

It is imperative to be sensitive towards the special needs of a differently abled person in regards to reading and acquiring knowledge. Library's dedicated section for visually impaired people - The Hellen Keller Unit should be fully functional and upgraded regularly. Presently the Hellen Keller Unit for Visually impaired users comprises of:

- Braille Material
- Audio CDs
- Circulation of braille material and audio CDs
- Two separate computer systems are installed with **JAWS** software and headphones for the students in the Library.
- Library provides the membership of "BRAILLE LIBRARY" (University of Delhi) to visually impaired students to access all the available resources.
- Library staff has been specially instructed / trained to help the special students wherever required.

Future upgrade of the available software/services/devices should be made whenever deemed necessary.

Assistive Technology

Considering the special need of visually challenged students, College will provide assistive technology to facilitate their learning process.

Recording Room and recording facility is also available in the College, the students should be encouraged to avail the same.

Access to software like Angel-Pro and DAISY is imperative. Along with this, headphones, smartphones and also laptops will be made available for students/staff with disability whenever needed

Financial Assistance

All possible efforts will be made to give economic assistance to the needy students as per rules. Timely payment of writing fee to the writers is very important in ensuring that they have no problem in arranging for a writer for their class work and examination.

Co-curricular activities

Efforts should be made to increase participation of differently abled students in Cultural and Sports Activities by organizing relevant events.

Students at College should be sensitized to the special needs of differently abled students and should be encouraged to assist them and make all possible efforts to include them in class discussions, projects, and College activities.

Their active participation in cultural and sport activities should be ensured. A short trip keeping their requirements and interest in mind can be organized. To challenge and encourage students mentally, competitive events should be planned.

Staff and Students

It is imperative to be sensitive to the needs of differently abled. Care should be taken that staff and students in their interaction with them should be empathetic and inclusive.

It is everyone's responsibility to provide a conducive environment to acquire knowledge and explore their potential.

Staff should encourage differently abled students to avail the separate provision for Assistance in Admission and Examination.

Students should be made aware about the Student Union of Persons with Disability so that they feel empowered.

Students should be made aware of the recognition and award given to the students with disability so that they can avail the same.




Figure 1 Letter from Dean Regarding waiver of fees in respect of Persons with Physical Disability

SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES AS PER THE MANDATORY PROVISIONS OF PWD ACT, UNCRPD AND DECISIONS OF HON'BLE COURTS

Dear Sir/ Madam,

As you are aware, the Equal Opportunity Cell, University of Delhi is working for the empowerment of students with disabilities to give them equal opportunities in higher education, in this context we are duty bound to provide facilities and assistance to our students with disabilities and request you to support the University in this endeavor.

The following are some of the necessary directions which must be implemented to facilitate our students with disabilities and also to honor the decisions of the Hon'ble High Court and the PwD act and the mandatory provisions of UNCRPD.

A. The University of Delhi through the Equal Opportunity Cell in the year 2008 had got an access audit done on all its building and those of its colleges to recommend infrastructural additions and changes such as Ramps, Tactile Path, Accessible Toilets, Lifts, Braille Symbols and Signage's, auditory signals in lifts etc. We must remember that the University and its colleges, hostels are committed to comply with and implement these recommendations. As per Section 46 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995, the Universities are directed by the Hon' able Courts to provide requisite facilities and uphold the letter and spirit of this Act. We once again request you to kindly implement the Access Audit Report at the earliest in case you have not done so.

We request you to kindly arrange volunteers for reading for the visually impaired students of your institution. The visually impaired students require volunteers for reading books and for preparing assignments. You can take the help of NSS volunteers for this purpose. The EOC also provides this service to students who approach us but we are not in a position to provide volunteers for all the students. As far as students with other disabilities are concerned they should be provided with volunteers to assist them in their day-to-day activity. It is further requested to provide these students with assistive devices like: Plextalk, Angel recording device, Hearing Aids, Wheelchairs, Accessible Computers etc., Signers and accessible reading materials. Libraries should also be provided with instant reading device for conversion study material in accessible format.

- C. It has been observed that many of the Enabling Units of the Colleges/ Departments are not yet fully functional. We once again request you to strengthen the Enabling Unit by extending your personal intervention and support to encourage the faculties to take active part in supporting these students to pursue their studies.
- **D.** Sensitize the staff (both teaching and non-teaching) for a better and friendly environment for Students with Disabilities.
- E. Special Arrangement's must be made for the ensuing semester/ house examination and facilities such as writers/ interpreters/ extra time/ one invigilator for one student should be implemented without any hurdle. Students with Disabilities should not be made to run here and there for any kind of problem.
- F. Additional seats in the hostel must be provided to such students as per the new guidelines issued by the University No. Aca.I/2012 dated August 31, 2012 and due procedure to fill up these seats must be followed.
- G. Fee waiver as per the new guidelines issued by the University Circular No. Aca.I/082/2001/PwD/2012-13/355 dated September 13, 2012 and Hostel Concession/ waiver of fess in respect PwD by the University Circular No. Aca.I/082/2001/PwD/2012-13/356 dated September 13, 2012 must be implemented.
- I. All possible supports as far as possible must be extended to such students.

In this context, we requested vide letter No. EOC/3/2011 dated April 28, 2011 for information on Enabling Units in the college of the University. We regret to inform that we have received responses from only 38 colleges so far. As per the HEPSN scheme (HIGER EDUCATION FOR PERSONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS) of Merged Schemes of UGC's XIth Plan, 2009, every institution is recommended to create an Enabling Unit for persons with disabilities. If you have created this unit in your institution then kindly provide all the details as per the As per UGC letter No. F. No. 10-3/2010(SCT) dated March 31, 2011 addressed to the Registrar, University of Delhi from the University Grant Commission "it is desirable to have a person with disability among the faculty members as coordinator and to involve the participation of differently-abled, so that real stake holders are benefited". In light of the above, please send us the Name, Designation and Contact details of the Coordinator and other members, if any, of the The Merged Schemes also allow for an Equal Opportunity Cell (EOC) in addition to the Enabling Unit; if you have set up an EOC in addition to the Enabling Unit, kindly provide similar details of the same. Under Component 3 of the HEPSN of the "Schemes for Persons with Disabilities" of the Merged Schemes provisions are to be made for special equipment to augment educational services for disabled persons. Please provide us information about the number of such assistive devices including computers with screen reading software, scanners, mobility devices, procured by the College under the ad-hoc grant of Rs. 1.5 Lakh provided by the UGC for this purpose.




Figure 7 UGC guidelines for Higher Education for Persons with Special Needs

c. To gather orders dealing with fee concessions, examination procedures, reservation policies, etc., pertaining to differently-abled persons.

d. To assess the educational needs of differently abled persons enrolled in the higher education institutes to determine the types of assistive devices to be procured.

e. To conduct awareness programmes for teachers of the institute about the approaches to teaching, evaluation procedures, etc., which they should address in the case of differently-abled students.

f. To study the aptitude of differently-abled students and assist them in getting appropriate employment days pertaining to disability such as the World Disabled Day, White Cane Day, etc., in the institute and also in the heighbourhood in order to create awareness about the capabilities of differently-abled persons.

h. To ensure maintenance of special assistive devices procured by the higher education institute under the HEPSN scheme and encourage differently-abled persons to use them for enriching their learning experiences.

i. To prepare annual reports with case histories of differently-abled persons who are benefited by the HEPSN scheme sanctioned to the higher education institute.

An expert team appointed by the University Grants Commission will carry out evaluation of the functioning of the Enabling Unit from time-to-time to enrich their services to differently-abled persons.

Component 2

Providing Access to Differently-abled persons find difficult for their day-to-day functioning. The colleges under this scheme are expected to address accessibility related issues as per the stipulations of the Persons with Disabilities Act 1995, and ensure that all existing structures as well as future construction projects in their campuses are made disabled friendly. The institutes should create special facilities such as ramps, rails and special toilets, and make other necessary changes to suit the special needs of differently-abled persons. For this purpose, the UGC will make

Allowance to visually challenged permanent teachers will be Rs.18000/- p.a. The amount is to be utilized for the following purposes:

(a) Payment to Reader
(b) Purchase of Braille Books/ Material
(c) Purchase of Braille Books/ Material
(d) Any other related/ required material/ equipment for research, teaching and learning. The amount payable to Reader shall not exceed Rs.550/- per hour. i. Assistance to the Postgraduate Colleges and Undergraduate Colleges to the tune of Rs.50,000/- and Rs.30,000/- per annum respectively. The honorarium for the Advisor shall be at the rate of Rs.1000/- per month.

ii. Rs.25,000/- per annum to organize a short-term course on positive discrimination of SC and ST for national development at the beginning of every academic session for newly enrolled students. At the end of the programme, the students may be asked to write a summary of what they have learnt and a certificate may be issued to them.




Figure 11 Bills and invoice/ purchase order/ AMC in support of facility and Battery operated stair climber




Figure 12 Bills and invoice/ purchase order/ AMC in support of facility and Battery operated stair climber




Figure 13 Bills and invoice/ purchase order/ AMC in support of facility and Battery operated stair climber




Figure 14 Bills and invoice/ purchase order/ AMC in support of facility and Battery operated stair climber




Figure 15 Bills and invoice/ purchase order/ AMC in support of facility and Battery operated stair climber




Figure 16 Bills and invoice/ purchase order/ AMC in support of facility and Battery operated stair climber




Figure 17 Bills and invoice/ purchase order/ AMC in support of facility and Battery operated stair climber
