Detail of achievements of the centre



Data on the Number of Students

At present, the centre has 238 students for B.A Prog and 183 students for B.com in the year, 321 students for B.A Prog and 136 students for B.com in the second year and 282 students for B.A Prog and 147 students for B.com for the final year.

All the faculty members for the centre are directly recruited from the NCWEB office situated in the North Campus.

Due to lockdown in the initial months and abiding by the social distancing measures as per the government directorial, the lectures are being held in the online mode (via Google Meet) for all the batches. In addition, the faculties share the classroom links, study material and supplementary notes, assignment questions and collection of IA responses etc. through the Google Meet web portal.
