- Paper-II – Only for those who apply for the posts of Junior Statistical Officer.
- Paper-III – Only for those who are shortlisted in Tier-I for Paper-III i.e., for the posts of Assistant Audit Officer/ Assistant Accounts Officer.

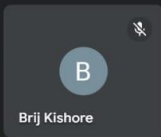

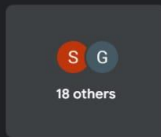
