On the 29th of January, 2024, PRAYAS - The Placement and Internship Cell of Mata Sundri College for Women, organized an insightful offline session titled Study Abroad at Mata Gujri Hall. She outlined the necessary documents, such as transcripts, SOP, LOR, and study permits, and covered the language proficiency exams like IELTS and CELPIP. Ms. Marble also mentioned prominent universities, including the University of Toronto, McGill University, and the University of British Columbia.

The discussion then shifted to Australia, where both speakers highlighted the relaxed work-study environment and the welcoming nature of Australian universities. The required documents for studying in Australia include academic transcripts, an SOP, LORs, financial statements, and health insurance. The speakers also reviewed key entrance exams like IELTS, TOEFL, and PTE and highlighted top-tier universities such as the University of Melbourne, the Australian National University, and the University of Sydney.

In the concluding segment, the speakers encouraged students to ask questions and share their concerns. Students provided positive feedback, appreciating the detailed information on the application processes, entrance exams, and insights into top universities. Many expressed a newfound confidence in exploring international education opportunities. Overall, the "Study
