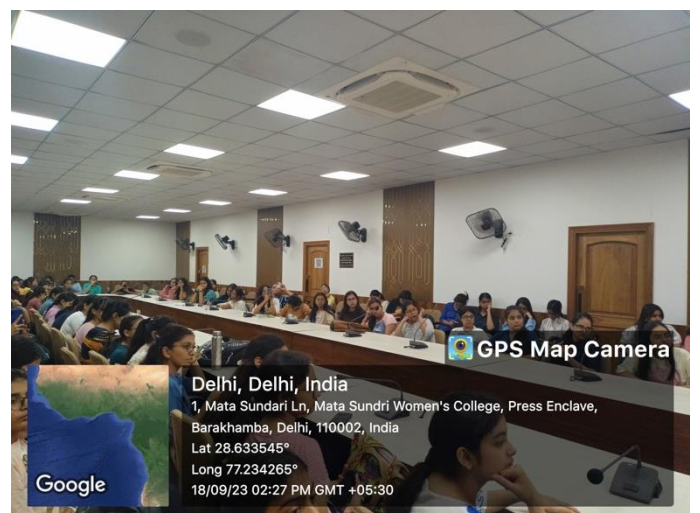
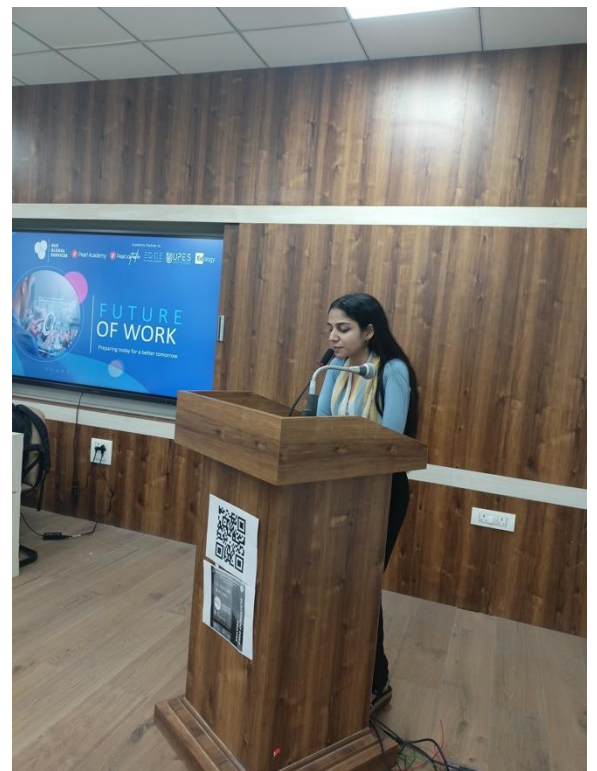
There were 89 registrations out which 72 participants appeared for the workshop.
