To educate students about the actuarial career and provide them with a roadmap to career success, **Willis Towers Watson** conducted a pre-placement talk on **6<sup>th</sup> September 2023**.

**Garima Chawla, Gayathri Khanna, Priyanka Dudi, Vikky Aggarwal, Raghav Sharma, Sakshi Rawat and Tisha Goel** were the speakers at the event. All the students who had registered participated in the pre-placement talk. The session started at 10:30 am on Microsoft Teams.

The event began with **Garima Chawla**, a representative from WTW, introducing herself and his colleagues to the audience. The agenda of the talk was then outlined, which was to discuss the key components and skills required for a successful career as an actuary and provide information about WTW.

**Garima** and **Priyanka** began by defining what an actuary is and the path to becoming one. They explained that an actuary is a business professional who uses their knowledge of mathematics, statistics, and finance to assess the financial impact of risks and uncertainties. They then provided insights into the skills required for a successful career as an actuary, such as critical thinking, problem-solving, communication, and the ability to work well in a team.


