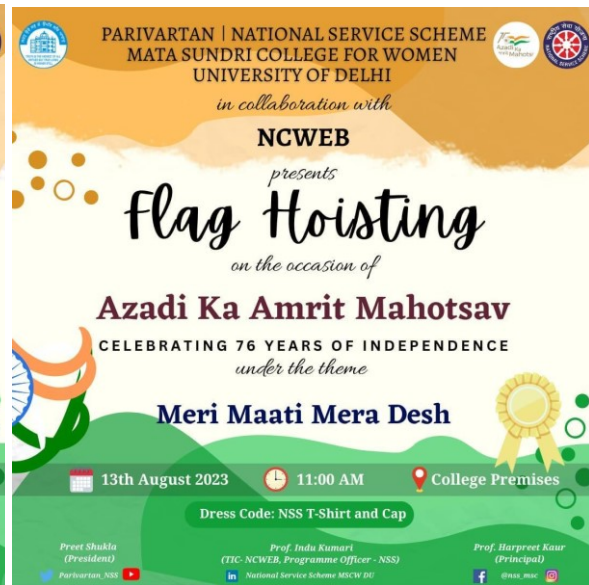


Figure 2: Poster and Picture of Prabhat Pheris and Flag Hoisting

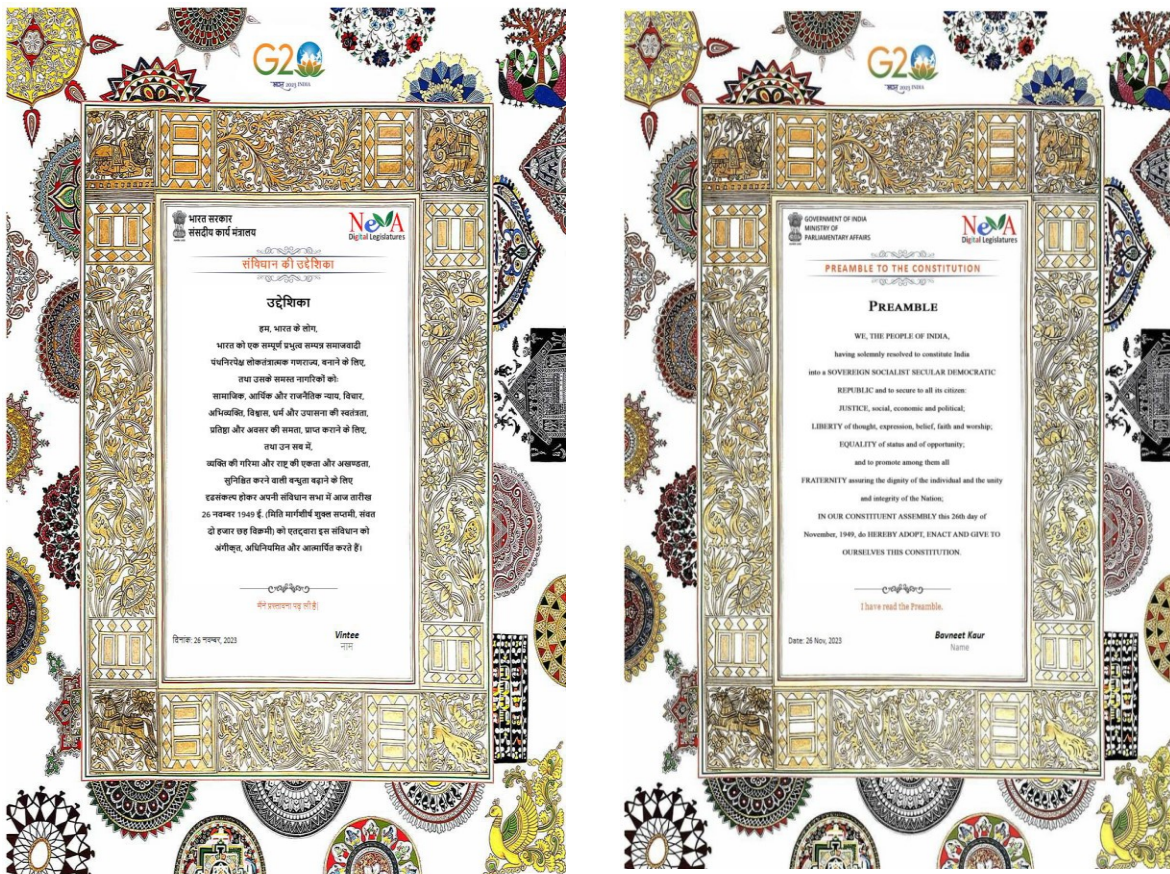


Figure 12: Celebrating Constitution Day

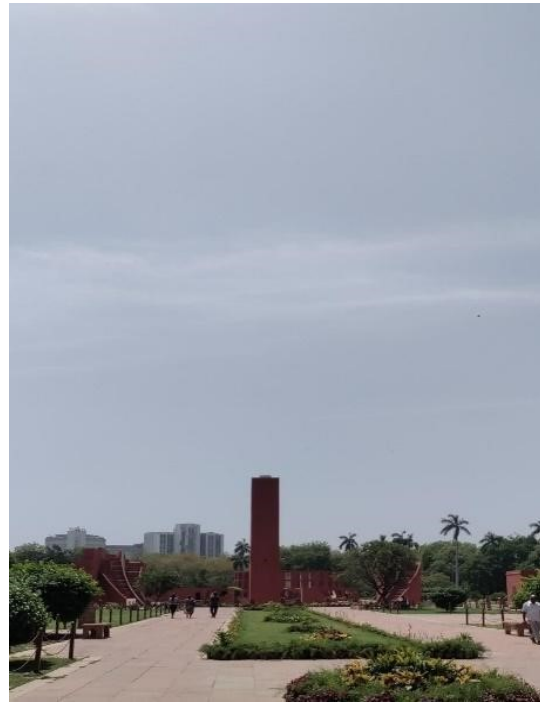


Figure 23: Student visiting Heritage sites on World Heritage day

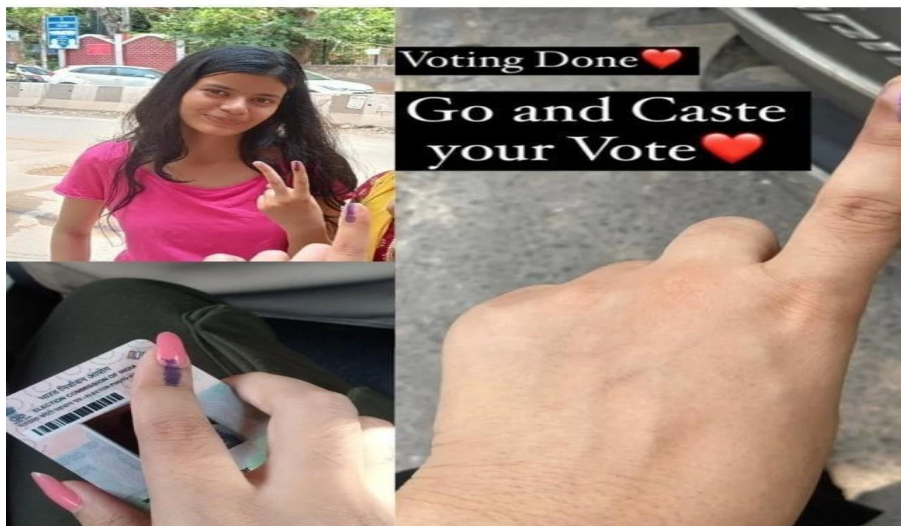
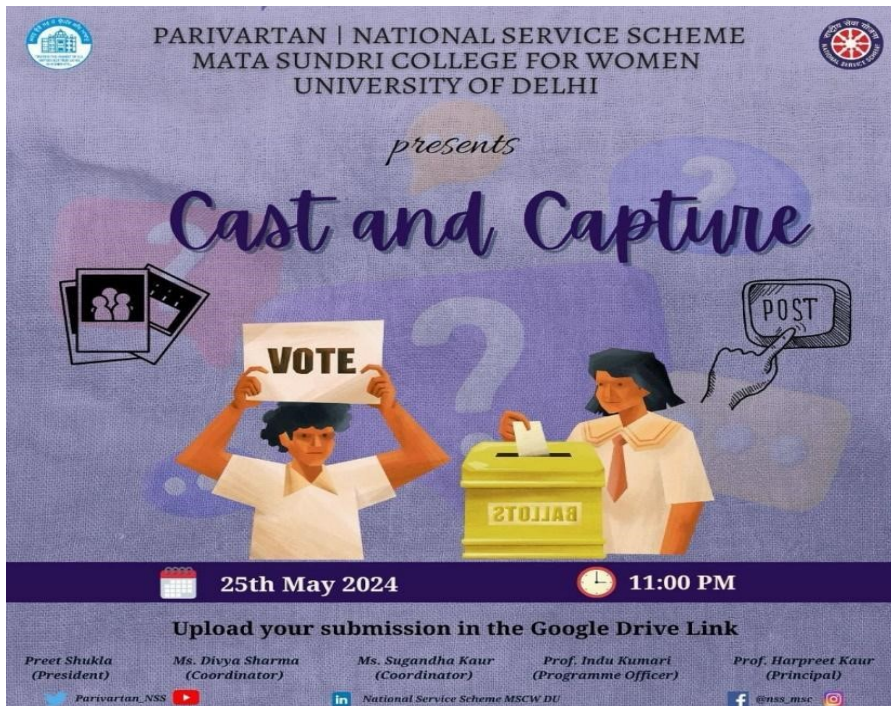


Figure 24: Students celebrating the spirit of democracy and encouraging civic participation in this online event.
