Name of College, List of Participants, and Script.
2. Play could be in English, Hindi, Bi-Lingual, or a Musical Drama.
3. Use of flammable substances such as Candles, Matches, Cigarettes, or any Alcoholic product during a performance on stage is not allowed and will result in disqualification.
4. One team can have a maximum of 15 Actors.
5. A team can have five backstage/prop managers, one light in charge, one sound in charge, and a round-up artist (if any, they must be registered).
6. The performance can be an original or an adaptation. There are no constraints regarding that. Inappropriate content, religious blasphemy, and Vulgarity/Obscenity will NOT be tolerated.
7. No team is allowed to spoil the stage.
8. In any case the Judge's decision will be final.

#### Stage II – Rebuttal & Interjections:

- Interjections may be raised with speaker's consent
- Must be relevant, policy-oriented, and respectful

- Content and research
- Policy analysis and state relevance
- Clarity and coherence
- Delivery and role portrayal
- Attire and dress-up (representation of the common citizen)
- Quality of rebuttals and interjections

## AWAAZ-E-SAARANG: THE COMMON MAN SPEAKS



### OBJECTIVE

To encourage critical evaluation of climate governance and public policy by enabling participants to articulate state-specific issues from a citizen-centric perspective.

#### State Representation:

- Each participant shall represent one Indian state.

Only one participant per state will be permitted.

States will be allotted on a first-come, first-serve basis.

- Arguments must be grounded in state-specific data, policies, and lived realities.

#### Language of Speech:

Speeches may be delivered either in Hindi or English.

Switching languages during the speech is strictly prohibited.

### TIME STRUCTURE

1. Citizen Statement: 2.5 minutes
2. Grace Time: 30 Seconds
3. Rebuttal / Interjection Time: 1 minute

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Strict adherence to time limits.
2. Arguments must be state-specific and topic-relevant.
3. Offensive or inappropriate language is prohibited.
4. Interjections only with speaker consent.
5. No personal attacks.
6. Data used must be accurate.
7. Parliamentary decorum must be maintained.
8. Misconduct may lead to disqualification.
9. Judges' decision shall be final.
