

‘Narratives: As Pedagogical Resource’

Talk titled ‘Narratives: As Pedagogical Resource’ (part 1 of the series on narratives) conducted on August 1, 2018 for students of B.El.Ed. III and IV year and the performance titled “Narrative of Magicians as Performance” (part 2 of the series) was conducted on September 8, 2018.
