## "What after BSc(Hons.) CS: Preparing for Higher Studies"

Placement & Internship Cell, Mata Sundri College for Women, in collaboration with **Department of Computer Science**, Mata Sundri College for Women organized a **Career Guidance Session** with an aim to inform about the various activities conducted by the Cell and significance of internships your field of study for successful outcomes after graduation. The session was conducted for Computer Science first year students on **January 22, 2022 from 6:30 PM IST to 9:00PM IST over Google Meet** which was attended by **89 students**. The duration of the session was 2.5 hours.

Ms. Falak Hasija took session on how to prepare for NIMCET and at IGDTUW entrance tests for MCA. She also shared her experience of studying at IGDTUW. She also informed what rank to score for getting admissions in various NITs. She discussed about paper pattern of IGDTUW entrance test and its marking scheme.

Ms. Mehak Makkar told about various MBA entrance tests such as CAT, SNAP by Symbiosis, XAT by Xavier's, IIFT and NMAT and also informed what all subjects to prepare and focus on such as Data Interpretation, Logical Reasoning, Maths, etc. She discussed about the major domains of MBA.
