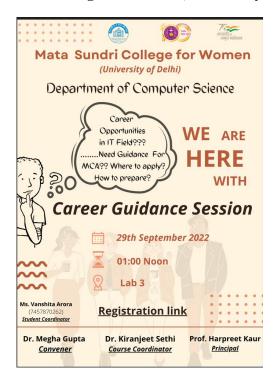
Report of Career Guidance Session

The Departments of Computer Science, Mata Sundri College for Women organized a Career Guidance Session for B.Sc(H) Computer Science/Maths/Stats and other interested students on 29th September 2022. The session provided exposure to the students, and provided a chance to enhance their knowledge in the subject area.

The session was inaugurated by our college Principal Prof. Harpreet Kaur. She appreciated the efforts of the organizing team headed by Course Coordinator **Dr. Kiranjeet Sethi**, Convener **Dr. Megha Gupta**. In her welcome speech, Hon. The books include varied topics of Maths namely calculus, Discrete Mathematics, Statistics and Operation Research, Real Analysis, etc. Presently, he is working as a Director of LANDMARK INSTITUTE, a remarkable Institute well known over the whole of North India for imparting quality coaching for the MCA Entrance Exam.

A total of 50 students from Mathematics, Computer Science, Statistic, Economics+Maths, History honors, MCom, BAP(ECO+MATHS) courses attended the session that was conducted in Lab 3, Mata Sundri College from 01:00 PM to 02:00 PM.

Mr. Ritukar Chadha focused on the institutes offering MCA/M.SC post-graduation courses such as NITs, DU, IGDTUW etc. He explained the major difference between MCA and M.Sc. He told the students about the I.T jobs trend for next 20 years in Product based companies (Google, amazon etc.) and Services based companies (TCS, Infosys etc.). He explained the eligibility requirements to get jobs in I.T sector. He explained the major MCA entrance exams patterns such as NIMCET, CUET-PG. And also, how easily these exams could be cracked. Her presentation was appreciated by all.
