Meraki - The Literary Society of the English department organized its annual inter-college festival, *Bookmarked '24* on 21st February, 2024. Several competitive events formed the fest and received active participation from more than 20 colleges and institutes across Delhi. This year's fest was based on the theme 'Multilingualism in India'.

The festival began with the launch of the 12th Issue of *Verbos Incendium,* the magazine published by the English department. Principal, Prof. Harpreet Kaur and IQAC director Dr. Lokesh Kumar Gupta were Chief Guests, and Dr. Kiranjeet Sethi (the founding editor of the magazine) was the Guest of Honor.
