“Disciplines Without Epistemology”

An inter-disciplinary lecture was conducted by the Department of Mathematics in collaboration with the IQAC and Academic Committee on January 20, 2023 at 1pm.

The session began with a warm welcome speech by Dr. Rama Verma. In her speech she welcomed the guest speaker Dr. Garima Mani Tripathi, teachers and the participants. After a formal Introduction of the guest speaker, Rama ma'am also offered a planter to Garima ma'am as a token of appreciation and respect.

Dr. Garima Mani began her lecture on “Disciplines Without Epistemology” with basic introductions about different disciplines, their meanings, connotations and examples.
