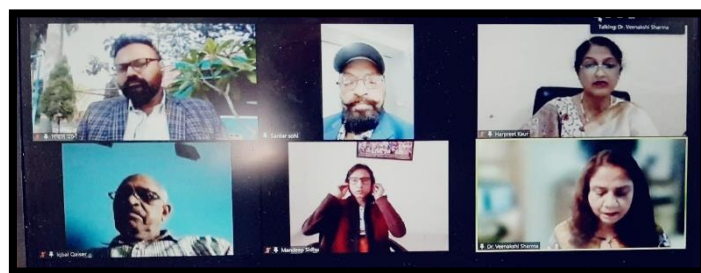


International Conference 26th to 28th November 2021
