This meeting was held in order to reconnect with the alumni and celebrate their success and various achievements. It also served the purpose of facilitating the career related guidance to the junior students. The event took place on the online platform ZOOM. The event was hosted by the council members of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year, namely, Mehakpreet (3<sup>rd</sup> year), Deepika (3<sup>rd</sup> year), Suman (3<sup>rd</sup> year), Akanksha (2<sup>nd</sup> year), Chhavi (2<sup>nd</sup> year), Rashmi (2<sup>nd</sup> year) and Parul (2<sup>nd</sup> year). A
