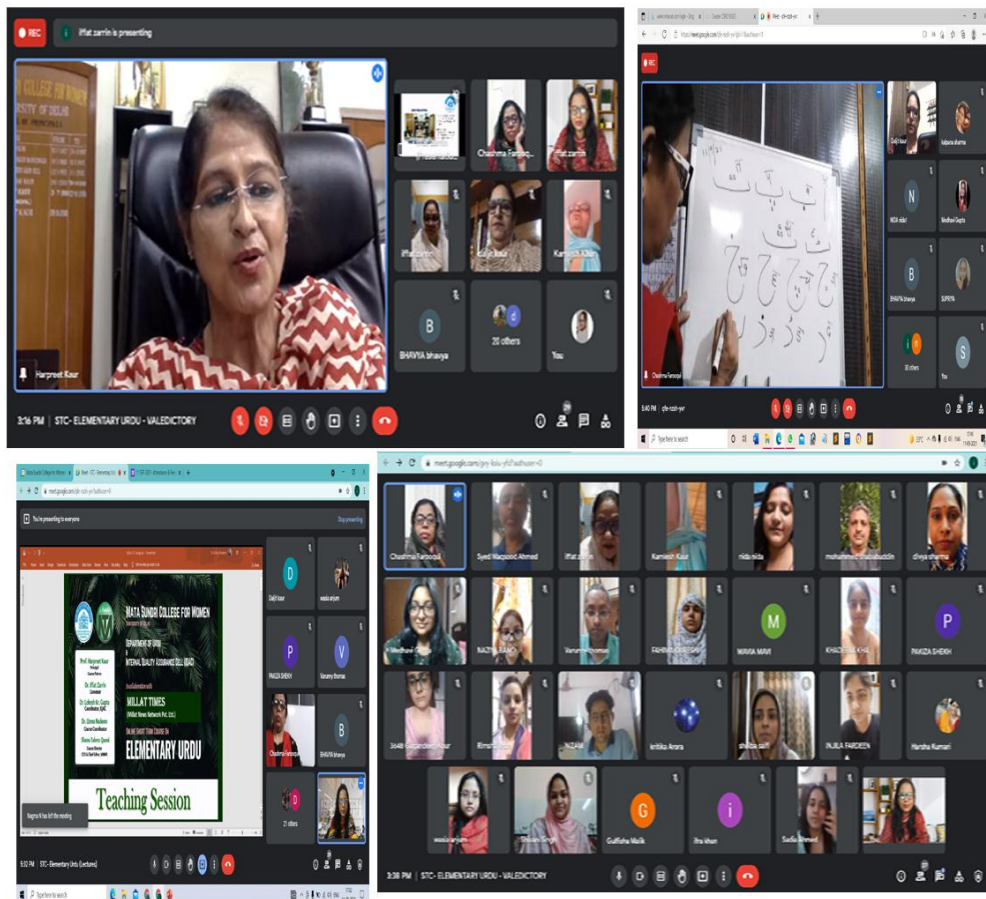

Total 66 participants of different age groups were registered for this course from various institutions all across the country. The course was conducted entirely in the online mode. The classes were held after college hours and on weekends and weekdays. The course was highly interactive, participative, and action-oriented. After completion of each module oral and written tests were conducted through google platform to understand their understanding of

the lectures. On the basis of performance E - Certificates were issued to the participants after the completion of the course. The course proved to be a huge success. It was highly advantageous and provided a comprehensive knowledge of Urdu language and literature to the participants.
