TOPIC- THE CASE COMPETITION

Arthavrishti, the Economics Society of Mata Sundri College for Women in collaboration with Advait, the BA Programme Society, successfully organised a case competition under Arthamanthan. The event was conducted on 9th APRIL 2026 in Mata Gujri Hall of Mata Sundri College for Women, where teams from different colleges competed. The competition is structured in three comprehensive rounds. First and second rounds were performed in online mode and shortlisted candidates got to participate in the third offline round. The event featured five teams competing in round three by presenting their PPTs to the judging panel.



The third round was an extension of the previous round which included the financial analysis of Formula 1, a global motorsport entity along with proposing the suggestion for long-term stability. Teams were judged on the basis of their critical thinking, analytical skills, confidence and clarity. The cross-questioning of the strategies and approaches by judges was the most challenging segment.
