Mata Sundri College for Women, University of Delhi, in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), organised a One-Day Awareness and Sensitization Programme on **“Ganga Samwad and Ganga Pariprekshya: A Walk-in Photo Exhibition”** on 29th January, 2026 under the Blended Capacity Building Programme for Stakeholders of River Ganga – Phase II. The programme aimed to promote awareness, capacity building, and stakeholder participation in river rejuvenation initiatives under the Namami Gange Mission.

The programme commenced with registration and a welcome note (10:30 A.M.), followed by an Introductory Address by **Dr. Saket Bihari**, Associate Professor, IIPA, who highlighted the importance of public engagement and capacity building for sustainable river governance. This was followed by the **Special Address** by **Prof. Harpreet Kaur**, Principal, Mata Sundri College for Women, who underscored the role of educational institutions in fostering environmental awareness and social responsibility. The **Presidential Address** was delivered by **Shri Amitabh Ranjan**, Registrar, IIPA, who emphasized grassroots governance, public administration, and citizen participation in environmental conservation. After the Special Address, a **felicitation ceremony** was organised to honour the distinguished guests from IIPA, reflecting institutional collaboration and mutual appreciation.

The technical sessions (11:30-12:30) included discussions on **Our Role in Ganga Rejuvenation, Yamuna Conservation and Rejuvenation Efforts, NMCG Initiatives, and Public Participation – Jan Bhagidari**, delivered by experts from IIPA and Dr. Kavita Singh from Mata Sundri College For Women. Cultural

performances such as the **Ganga Anthem** and thematic songs (Ganga Re, Kartvaya Song) enriched the programme. A student debate (12:30-1:20 PM) on “**Climate Change: Reality or Myth**” encouraged critical thinking and active participation.

The **walk-in photo exhibition** emerged as a key highlight of the programme, offering participants a powerful visual journey through the cultural, ecological, and conservation narratives of the River Ganga. The exhibition enabled students and visitors to connect emotionally and intellectually with the themes of river rejuvenation, sustainability, and public responsibility. To assess the impact of the programme, a **feedback form was circulated among participants**, and the responses received were **overwhelmingly positive**, reflecting high levels of satisfaction, enhanced awareness, and appreciation for the interactive and multidisciplinary approach adopted during the event. The event was concluded around 1:30 PM with a vote of thanks from IIPA team , followed by refreshments for dignitaries and students.
