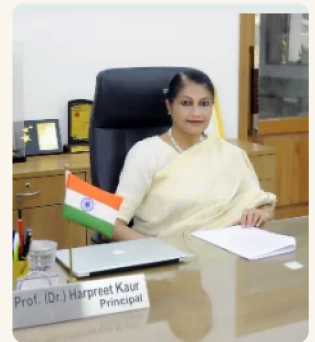

# How to actually get in.

From your bedroom in May to attending Day 1 in July — the full sequence, in five steps.

- 1 Register for CUET**  
Apply for CUET (UG) 2026 at [cuet.nta.nic.in](https://cuet.nta.nic.in) in the same subjects you took in Class XII.
- 2 Apply to DU**  
Once CUET results are out, register on the DU CSAS portal at [admission.uod.ac.in](https://admission.uod.ac.in).
- 3 Fill preferences**  
On the CSAS dashboard, add MSCW and every programme you'd be happy with. Rank them carefully.
- 4 Wait for allocation**  
DU runs multiple allocation rounds based on your CUET scores and your category.
- 5 Accept & report**  
Got MSCW? Accept the seat, pay the fee, and report on campus for document verification. Done.

## TEACHING TRACKS — READ THIS

B.El.Ed. follows the standard CUET route. ITEP does not use CUET — you must appear for the NCET via NTA. Final ITEP merit = 50% Class XII + 50% NCET score.

## BEFORE YOU REPORT — CHECKLIST

- ✓ Class X certificate & Class XII marksheet
- ✓ CUET (UG) 2026 scorecard from NTA
- ✓ Sikh Minority certificate (DSGMC)
- ✓ Category / ECA / Sports certificates
- ✓ Certified translations, if needed

*Names must match your CUET application — letter for letter. Quota certificates must be dated May 2022 – April 2026.*

# How seats are split — in plain English.

As a Minority Institution, MSCW dedicates half of all base seats to Sikh minority candidates.

50%

**Unreserved (UR)**

Open to all candidates.

50%

**Sikh Minority**

Valid DSGMC certificate required.

## Extra (supernumerary) seats

*Added on top of the base 50 / 50 split.*

Persons with Disability (PwBD)	5%
Armed Forces Children / Widows	5%
Kashmiri Migrants	up to 5%
ECA & Sports Talent	up to 5%
Foreign Nationals	10%
Single Girl Child	1 seat / programme

## Applying under Sikh Minority?

The DSGMC e-certificate — the portal process:

- 1 Visit [dsgmc.in](https://dsgmc.in)
- 2 Register using your email + OTP
- 3 Upload your documents and required videos
- 4 Wait for e-certificate verification

Video declarations (.mp4): the candidate and her father / guardian each record a short declaration affirming they follow the teachings of Guru Granth Sahib Ji and Sikh traditions, and do not trim or cut their hair.

**PRO TIP**

Start your DSGMC certificate **before** your CUET result. Verification takes time, and CSAS deadlines wait for nobody.

## STILL WONDERING?

# Your most-asked questions, answered.

### What is the fee range for 2026?

UG courses range from ~₹12,000 (B.A. Punjabi) to ~₹43,000 (ITEP) for the full programme. Most fall between ₹26,000 and ₹34,000.

### Do I need to be Sikh to apply?

No. 50% of base seats are open to all (UR). The other 50% are for Sikh minority candidates with a valid DSGMC certificate.

### How do placements work?

The Prayas Cell coordinates campus placements and internships, with strong recruiters across BFSI, EdTech, consulting and media.

### Do you have a hostel?

A girls' hostel is under construction. Until it opens, outstation students typically stay in nearby PGs in Daryaganj or the ITO area.

### What CUET score do I need?

Cut-offs vary every year and by course. For high-demand courses (Psychology, Economics, CS, Commerce).

### Can I change my course later?

Switching after admission is governed by DU rules and is not allowed. Choose your CSAS preferences carefully the first time.
