Field projects:

In 2019-20,15 student undertook field projects under the mentorship of different faculty members of the department. During this period, 81 students of the psychology department undertook internship.

Honours and recognition received by teachers:

Curriculum Development:

Faculty members have been actively involved in curriculum development.
