The government of Delhi has been always been motivating students to create and present and this time too they have come up with the competition. Parivartan, the NSS unit of Mata Sundri College for Women organized the "REGISTER YOURSELF AS A VOTER DIGITALLY" under VOTER UTSAV. Around 11 volunteers participated in the video-making competition in collaboration with the DELHI GOVERNMENT. Volunteers were asked to submit our videos which is less than 3 minutes and the size limit is 10-50 MB by 9th November 2021 5 pm.

The top 5 entries were supposed to be awarded a cash prize of Rs. 5000 on National Voter's Day. It was a very creative yet fun event for all the volunteers. 11 Volunteers took part in it and explained why voting is very important for democracy and why every youngster should register himself/herself/themselves as a voter. All eligible citizens of India who have attained the age of 18 on the qualifying date can apply for a Voter ID card.

The election commission of India offers online voter registration for Indian citizens who have attained the age of 18 on the qualifying date i.e., 1st of January of each year). Citizens, can enrol himself/themselves as General Voters and fill Form no. 6 online at National Voters' Service Portal. Registered voters should also check their enrolment status. One can enrol as a Voter if they are an Indian citizen. If they have attained the age of 18 years on the qualifying date i.e., 1st of January of the year of revision of electoral roll. The volunteers explained all these details in their videos and also gave insight on our right to vote and its importance. The volunteers signed up for the event through a google form provided by the external agency and they also submitted their videos to NSS through the google drive link provided to them.
