## Report on Guru Tegh Bahadur National Conference

New Delhi: Minority Cell of Mata Sundri College organized a two-day national conference dedicated to the 400th birth anniversary of Guru Tegh Bahadur in collaboration with the Haryana Punjabi Sahitya Akademi. Scholars from Delhi, Punjab and Haryana participated in the subject.
