

## **Short Report on Student Orientation about Prayas-the Placement Cell**

The **PRAYAS – Placement & Internship Cell, Mata Sundri College for Women, University of Delhi**, organized a **Student Orientation Programme** for first- and second-year students on **17 August**, from **1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.** at **Bebe Nanki Hall**.

The session introduced students to **PRAYAS** and the opportunities available beyond the classroom, including **internships, placements, skill development, guidance, and workshops**. It focused on helping students explore career opportunities, develop relevant skills, and prepare for their future careers from an early stage.

The orientation aimed to help freshers understand **how the Placement and Internship Cell works, what opportunities it provides, and what they should do from the beginning of their college journey to become placement- and internship-ready**.

Key objectives included:

- Explain its functions, responsibilities, and how it supports students in internships and placements.
- Inform freshers about companies, internship opportunities, placement drives, and career-related programs.
- Familiarize students with registration, eligibility criteria, aptitude tests, group discussions, interviews, and offer procedures.
- Encourage students to build technical knowledge, communication skills, aptitude, resumes, and professional confidence from the first year.
- Explain the importance of maintaining academic performance, following PIC guidelines, meeting deadlines, and participating actively.

The orientation encouraged students to actively make use of the opportunities and resources provided by the Placement & Internship Cell.
