EARTHCON, the Eco Club of Mata Sundri College for Women, participated in the 8th Harit Umang Stakeholders & Green Champions Meet, focusing on the collective efforts towards creating a cleaner, greener, and more sustainable environment. The meeting highlighted Harit Umang's achievements, including its recent environmental sustainability award, global outreach, and support from the Pollution Control Board. Discussions also covered the upcoming 10th edition of WCF and the programme's increasing emphasis on practical, hands-on environmental knowledge. A visit to the Panasonic factory in Jhajjar was also proposed to provide participants with exposure to industrial sustainability, recycling, and waste-management facilities.

The meeting further involved discussions on strengthening waste-management initiatives, particularly the collection and recycling of used pens, paper, and e-waste. Institutions shared ideas for planning activities according to their academic calendars, while EarthCon highlighted its association with Harit Umang since 2020 and its previous participation in e-waste competitions, reuse workshops, and fabric upcycling activities. Suggestions were also made to integrate Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) more closely with the programme through tree plantation drives, SDG-focused seminars, and Green Champion badges, with approximately 25 Green Ambassadors proposed for each participating institution.
