The **Placement and Internship Cell**, a cornerstone of career advancement since 2005, has been at the forefront of bridging academic excellence with professional aspirations. Committed to providing students with diverse placement and internship opportunities, the Cell actively fosters **analytical**, **technical**, **and soft skills**, empowering students to set ambitious career goals and chart their paths to success. Strategic collaborations with industry leaders continue to create avenues for students to gain hands-on experience, preparing them for the ever-evolving corporate landscape.

Under the visionary leadership of Dr. Ashema Hasti (Convenor, Prayas) and Dr. Harshmeeta Soni (Co-Convenor, Prayas), the Placement and Internship Cell has witnessed a remarkable expansion in its outreach, corporate associations, and career-building initiatives. The student office bearers for the 2024-25 session include Ekangi Valecha (President, Roll No. MAT/22/21), Garima Chawla (Vice President, Roll No. BAP/22/109), Etika Patial (Secretary, Roll No. MAT/22/29), Prerna Aggarwal (Joint Secretary, Roll No. CSC/22/34), Sanya Aggarwal (Head Corporate Affairs, Roll No. STA/22/36), Arunima Kashyap (PR & Sponsorship Head, Roll No. BAP/22/1), Vibhuti Arora (Treasurer, Roll No. BCH/22/101), and Priyanka Das (Senior Coordinator, Roll No. CSC/22/36).

This academic year has been an exceptional one, with 91 students successfully placed in top firms and 296 students securing internships across leading organizations. The highest CTC reached an impressive ₹28.4 LPA, offered by D.E. Shaw, reflecting the growing recognition of the institution's talent pool in the corporate sector. Recruiters such as KPMG, Hindustan Recruiters, Clairvolex, CARS24, Internshala, Capgemini, D.E. Shaw, Hike Education, and ICICI Bank extended lucrative job offers across sectors like Finance, Consulting, Software Development, Data Analytics, Sales & Marketing, and Business Strategy.

The internship landscape has also seen unprecedented growth, with WTW India offering the highest stipend of ₹35,000 per month, while the average stipend stood at ₹10,000 per month. Companies such as D.E. Shaw, TravClan, Hike Education, and Elements HR provided students with hands-on experience in roles spanning Market Research, Digital & Performance Marketing, Actuarial Analysis, Relationship Management, and Public Relations, equipping them with industry-relevant skills and exposure.

The Placement and Internship Drives and Workshops were conducted in both online and offline modes, offering students a well-rounded professional development experience. The Cell successfully organized key events such as 'Vision IAS - Inter-College Competition,' 'BSR & Co. LLB Placement Talk,' 'Amigo Academy: Career Avenues in the Aviation Industry,' 'Teach for India Pre-Placement Talk,' 'K12 Pre-Placement Talk,' 'Global Education Fair' and 'Frenchat Placement Drive.' These events provided students with invaluable insights into diverse career paths, corporate expectations, and industry trends, ensuring they are well-prepared to navigate the professional world with confidence.

Career Symposium 2025: Now in its third edition, this highly anticipated Internship and Job Fair was organized on February 7-8, 2025, bringing together top recruiters, industry leaders, and ambitious students under one roof.

The event was inaugurated by Prof. (Dr.) Harpreet Kaur, Principal of Mata Sundri College for Women, with Mr. Tushar Kapoor (Co-founder, VSecurIT Solutions) as the Guest of Honor and Prof. Maninder Kaur (Director, GNIM, GGSIP University) as the Chief Guest. Under the leadership of Dr. Ashema Hasti (Convenor) and Dr. Harshmeeta Kaur Soni (Co-Convenor), and with the dedicated efforts of the PRAYAS team, the symposium evolved into a dynamic hub of career-building opportunities. This year's edition witnessed an exceptional turnout with 75 esteemed organizations offering diverse roles across industries. The offline segment on February 7, held at the college premises, facilitated direct networking, skill-based interactions, and on-the-spot recruitment, while the online segment on February 8 enabled students to connect with recruiters beyond geographical boundaries. Prominent recruiters included BluSmart, Hike Education, 6W Research, Taj Group Hotels, Elements HR, JETO Vacations, CSA Advisor, FNP, OD Works, Talent Organiser, and Leverage Edu, presenting a wide range of internship and full-time career prospects.
