WHAT IS RAGGING?

Ragging is any act that causes physical, mental or emotional harm or discomfort to another student.

It includes:

- Physical abuse
- Verbal abuse or teasing
- Bullying or intimidation
- Humiliation or insults
- Forcing to do unwanted acts
- Discrimination, bullying or exclusion based on religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origin, language, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.



RAGGING IS A PUNISHABLE OFFENCE



As per the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and University of Delhi Ordinances XV-B & XV-C, students found guilty of ragging shall face strict disciplinary action, including suspension, expulsion and legal consequences.

Stand up for others and report any incident.
